ENTSOG opens public stakeholder consultation on its Annual Work Programme (AWP) 2014

(Brussels, 15 July 2013)

On 9 July 2013, the ENTSOG Board approved the release of its draft Annual Work Programme 2014 for public consultation.

ENTSOG launches today a public stakeholder consultation on its Annual Work Programme 2014. As required in Regulation 715/2009 the consultation asks valuable input from stakeholders on the content and the given priorities.

Vittorio Musazzi, ENTSOG General Manager, said,

“ENTSOG is happy to receive feedback from all stakeholders as the identification of the correct projects and prioritisation for 2014 should be in line with the targets defined by the European Commission serving the further integration of the European gas market”.

The consultation starts today (15 July) and will be open until 7 September 2013.
