THE ROLE OF ENTSOG

The role of ENTSOG is to facilitate and enhance cooperation between national gas transmission system operators (TSOs) across Europe to meet European Union energy goals. Its objectives are to promote the completion of the internal market for gas and stimulate cross-border trade, ensure the efficient management and coordinated operation of the European gas network and facilitate the European network's sound technical evolution. ENTSOG is comprised of seconded staff from its members as well as directly hired staff and therefore the organisation is constantly under dynamic change and ready to offer new opportunities. The ENTSOG staff currently consists of 40+ people of 18 different nationalities, a good gender balance and representing 14 companies, which provides a unique and challenging international working environment.

ABOUT YOUR ROLE AS INTEROPERABILITY ADVISER

The ENTSOG System Operations Area facilitates **implemen**tation and monitoring of key EU legislation and contributes to further developing the EU legislation in the areas of interoperability and transparency.

In your new role, you will contribute to our work on **monitoring and functioning of the EU-wide gas network code** in the System Operation Area as well as the **development of a new EU Energy legislation** considering the European Green Deal with the aim to provide for a carbon-neutral Energy supply by 2050. In this respect you should be interested in how to apply the **Energy Efficiency First Principle** in the decisionmaking process for investments in the operation of TSOs infrastructure. In addition to feeding into the debate on the technical aspects of the energy transition, you will **focus on methane emission monitoring and reduction and carbon capture, transportation and storage of which**.

CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS

The Candidate will be **based in Brussels** and should be ready to **start work as soon as possible at the latest during Q3 of 2021**.

Appointees from ENTSOG Members will be seconded based on a contract between ENTSOG and the seconding TSO, usually for a period of typically 3 years.

SOME OF THE KEY RESPONSIBILITIES OF THIS ADVISER ROLE INCLUDE:

- support of the Members in implementation and monitoring of Interoperability & Data Exchange Network Code,
- the development of tools and recommendations for the technical cooperation of TSOs,
- managing ENTSOG's internal expert groups,
- cooperating with external experts and organizations' as well participation in dialogue with European Commission and ACER.
- Follow-up of meetings, workshops and projects related to the energy efficiency first principle, methane emissions and carbon capture, transport & storage.
 The development of own ideas, position papers or responses on these topics will be part of your work.

CANDIDATES SHOULD HAVE:

- at least 5 years professional experience,
- technical background, preferable degree in engineering or equivalent by experience,
- specific knowledge of the Network Code for Interoperability and Data and Data Exchange,
- specific knowledge on the energy efficiency first principle, methane emission and carbon capture, transport & storage topics, or at least be interested to work on these topics and take ownership of them,
- experience in data analysis related to scientific or engineering work, with fluent use of Microsoft Excel,
- general knowledge of the European gas market framework,
- proven ability to manage multiple projects and establish priorities,
- excellent writing and presentation skills in English.
