CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS

The Candidate will be **based in Brussels** and should be ready to **start work as soon as possible, preferably by December 2021**.

Candidates from ENTSOG Members (gas TSOs) are preferred: such secondment contracts are typically for a period of minimum 2-3 years. Candidates not applying from an ENTSOG Member will if selected be offered a two-year contract.
