# Conclusions



- > ENTSOG TP has been well-accepted by users, as, compared to the previous, it offers increased user friendliness, more tools for visualizing data, and increased quality and quantity of information
- > Data reliability is important for correct market operation and ENTSOG/TSOs shall have to work on improving current situation, based on the feedback received by users
- > Reporting of data following adoption of REMIT implementing acts is expected to start Nov 15 (ENTSOG TP) and April 2016 (TSOs). TSOs have already worked during a pilot project with ACER on the details of the communication. But timely implementation will require a lot of effort by all TSOs (and market participants in general).
- > Draft Tariff NC proposed by ENTSOG foresees increased transparency by TSOs on how the transmission tariffs are set and also on current and future tariff trends.
